Due to current events, exceptional measures have been introduced to combat the spread of the coronavirus.

- · Due to current events, exceptional measures have been introduced to combat the spread of the coronavirus.
- · Discos and large performance venues remain closed for an indefinite period
- Restaurants are open
- · Bars, cafes, and terraces are closed until further notice
- Shopping centres and department stores remain open (not more than one customer per 4 m²)The parks and gardens are open, until October 30Maximum capacity of 1,000 people for major events
- · Groups of 10 people in public places (outdoors and indoors) are prohibited
- · Closure of sports halls and gymnasiums as of September 28, 2020
- · Indoor and outdoor swimming pools are closed until further notice
- · The sale of alcohol to take away and the consumption of alcohol in public places is prohibited from 10pm
- · Libraries and media libraries remain open

PUBLIC AREAS

- As of Friday, 28 August 2020, and until further notice, wearing a face mask is compulsory in public areas and enclosed spaces, throughout the city of Paris and in the Inner Suburbs of Seine-Saint-Denis, Hauts-de-Seine and Val-de-Marne, under penalty of a fine of 135 euros.
- · The following persons are concerned: pedestrians and (kick) scooter users.
- Children under 11 years of age and persons engaged in physical activity such as running and cycling, and persons riding scooters and
 motorbikes are not required to wear a mask in the public area

REOPENING OF CULTURAL AND LEISURE VENUES

After their closure during confinement, Parisian cultural venues are gradually reopening to the public in compliance with strict health rules.

Trade fairs and trade shows as well as events held in marquees or big tops are all cancelled until further notice
